FILE FOR GRADUATION (REQUIRED)*:

File an online graduation application with the Office of the University Registrar at https://registrar.ucdavis.edu/graduate between these dates:

PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY (OPTIONAL):

If you intend to participate in a commencement ceremony, you must register online at www.ucdavis.edu/commencement.

JUNE 2022 CEREMONIES

Eligibility: 150 units completed by the end of Winter

Ceremony Dates: June 10 - June 12, 2022 Filing Period: March 21 - April 22, 2022

DECEMBER 2022 CEREMONY

Eligibility: 150 units completed by the end of Summer

Ceremony Date: December 10, 2022

Filing Period: TBD

OBTAIN MAJOR CHECK:

See your major advisor to confirm that you will satisfy your major requirements.

FILE MINOR PETITION:

If you are pursuing a minor, file a minor petition online at https://students.ucdavis.edu/ by the 10th day of instruction of your graduating quarter.

CANCELLATION OF GRADUATION:

Cancel your graduation online if you know that you will *not* satisfy your requirements. Refile for the quarter in which you will complete all degree requirements.

Pending transfer work must be received by specific deadlines; contact the Deans' Office for additional information.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

REDUCED COURSELOAD (RCL)**:

International students are eligible for part-time status during their final quarter. Getting approved is a two-part process:

- 1. **ACADEMIC:** You must file a Part-Time Status Petition with the Office of the University Registrar by the 10th day of instruction if you will be enrolled in 10 units or under during your final quarter: https://registrar.ucdavis.edu/registration/part-time
- 2. **IMMIGRATION:** You must submit an RCL request form through iGlobal by the 12th day of instruction if you will be enrolled in under 12 units during your final quarter: https://iGlobal.ucdavis.edu

OPTIONAL PRACTICAL TRAINING (OPT):**

An optional benefit for F-1 students once they complete all degree requirements. Interested students must attend an SISS in-person or online workshop. Visit http://siss.ucdavis.edu for workshop schedule times.
